

MORRISON MODEL AIRCRAFT FLYERS
MARCH 4, 2007

The March meeting was held at the home of Jim Fuller beginning with a potluck at 12:00 Noon. There were 6 members present.

Rick Stange reported a total of \$omitted in the treasury. An up-to-date membership list was handed out which included two new members: Larry McWorthy and Mike Chronister. Their membership forms were given to Darryl Miller to forward to Scott Hall. There are currently 14 paid members.

Rick Stange showed a sample of the sign he will make for the field. It will be made from 2' x 3' aluminum and will have the contact information including the phone number for the Park Ranger. This will be put on the fence.

Rick also had a sample of the sign to be put at the entrance to the field. The frame work would be made from PVC with a 4' x 8' plastic sheet with basically the same wording as the sign now carries. It will cost approximately \$250 to \$300. Darryl Miller made a motion to go ahead with the sign and have it ready to install on the work day in April. Dewey Caudill seconded the motion – motion carried. Rick will get the exact price and report back at the next meeting.

Darryl Miller is working on the sign to be put with the other park signs showing the way to the flying field. This would be placed at the 'T' intersection (coming from the marina). He will check with Mike (Park Ranger) to see if there are any restrictions on what it can say. It was suggested to put "RC Flying Field, Next Right".

The work day will be April 28th starting at 9:00 a.m. There will be a lot of work to do (build new toilet, put up sign, etc.).

The mower deck is almost done. It should have a set of new blades (Bud Jordan will take care of ordering), it needs to be reassembled and then it can be put back on the tractor. It will be finished for the work day.

Dick Landsiedel will check with Mike at the Park to see if they have all the material for the new toilet and also if he knows what if any crops will be planted around the field this year.

Darryl Miller reported on the status of the Fun Fly in July. He has received the sanction information from AMA and is in the process of putting together a letter to send out to various manufacturers, etc. to get donations for prizes. He will contact Phil Vernon in Davenport and give him all the info to put on their web site. Flyers are being made and will be sent out. Darryl also suggested that if anyone has anything thing at home they would like to donate for prizes, all would be welcomed.

The April meeting will be held April 1st at the field at 2:00 p.m.

Darryl Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jim Fuller.
