Two rounds will be flown with these tasks...and a third bonus flight will take place consisting of either one or both, a balloon break attempt...and a timed climb and glide to a spot landing.

We do have some prizes and donations lined up for the event, but Darryl requested we purchase some additional items, to be reimbursed from the entry fees. The members present approved this.
